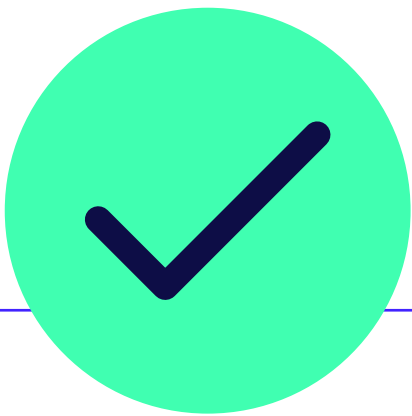


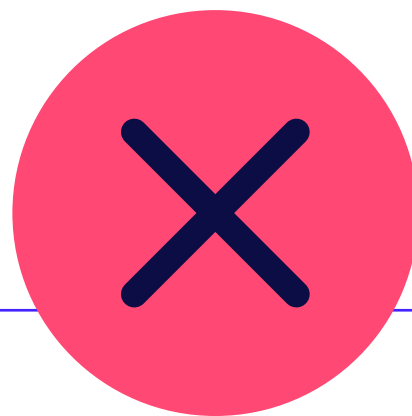
What Types of Artisan and Trade Contractors Can I Write With Coterie?
